

How To Qualify for the WABTA Classic

- ◆ You must be a W.A.B.T.A. member (dues paid before you fish the qualifying tournament) and fish at least four WABTA Open tournaments during the current year.
- ◆ You must finish in the top 20% of any WABTA sponsored qualifying tournament.
- ◆ The top four non-qualifying teams from the final team of the year standings will also qualify.
- ◆ If you fish all six (6) WABTA evens you automatically qualify for the Classic.
- ◆ Single qualifiers may pair up with other single qualifiers to fish the WABTA Classic. If you choose to fish alone, your daily bag limit will be reduced to five fish.

You will be a single qualifier if...

- ◆ Your partner is unable to fish the WABTA Classic

Facts about The WABTA Classic

The WABTA Classic is funded by your membership dues money and a portion of the WABTA tournament entry fees.

The WABTA Classic lake (and alternates) will be voted upon at the March 2011 WABTA membership meeting from a list of lakes to be announced.
